

# Connecting Network Resources to Windows Folders

MKLINK [[/D] | [/H] | [/J]] Link Designation

- /D - creating a symbolic link to the catalogue. The symbolic link to the file is created by default.
- /H - creating a hard link instead.
- /J - creating a connection for the catalogue.
- Link - the new symbolic link name.
- Destination - a path (relative or absolute), to which the new link refers.

To mount a network folder to the local catalogue, use the following command:

```
mklink /D "D:\path\to\folder\link" "\\server\share"
```
